Adult support

- Provide opportunities for cooking role play in the home corner.
- Have lots of recipe books and cooking magazines available for the children to look at both inside and outside.
- Model following recipe books as a set of instructions.
- Use vocabulary found in recipe books during role play.

Learning sequence

- Role-play cooking using recipe books as props.
- Looking at recipe books and magazines.
- Talk about what they can see in the pictures in a recipe book.
- Understand that recipe books are a set of instructions which can be followed to make a recipe.
- Learn new vocabulary and begin to read some of the instruction words used commonly in recipe books e.g. mix, stir.
