Henri Matisse (1869-1954) was one of the most influential French artists of the 20th century. From 1922, he worked regularly in Paris and Nice (where he died), producing prints and book illustrations, sculpture and the paper cut-outs, which are among the best known of his later works. Matisse was especially renowned for his use of colour.
