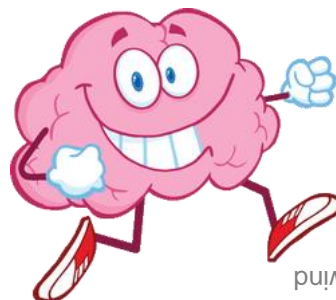


## PTA
