## Families First



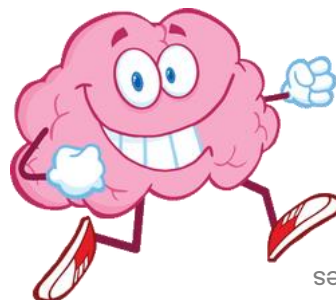
